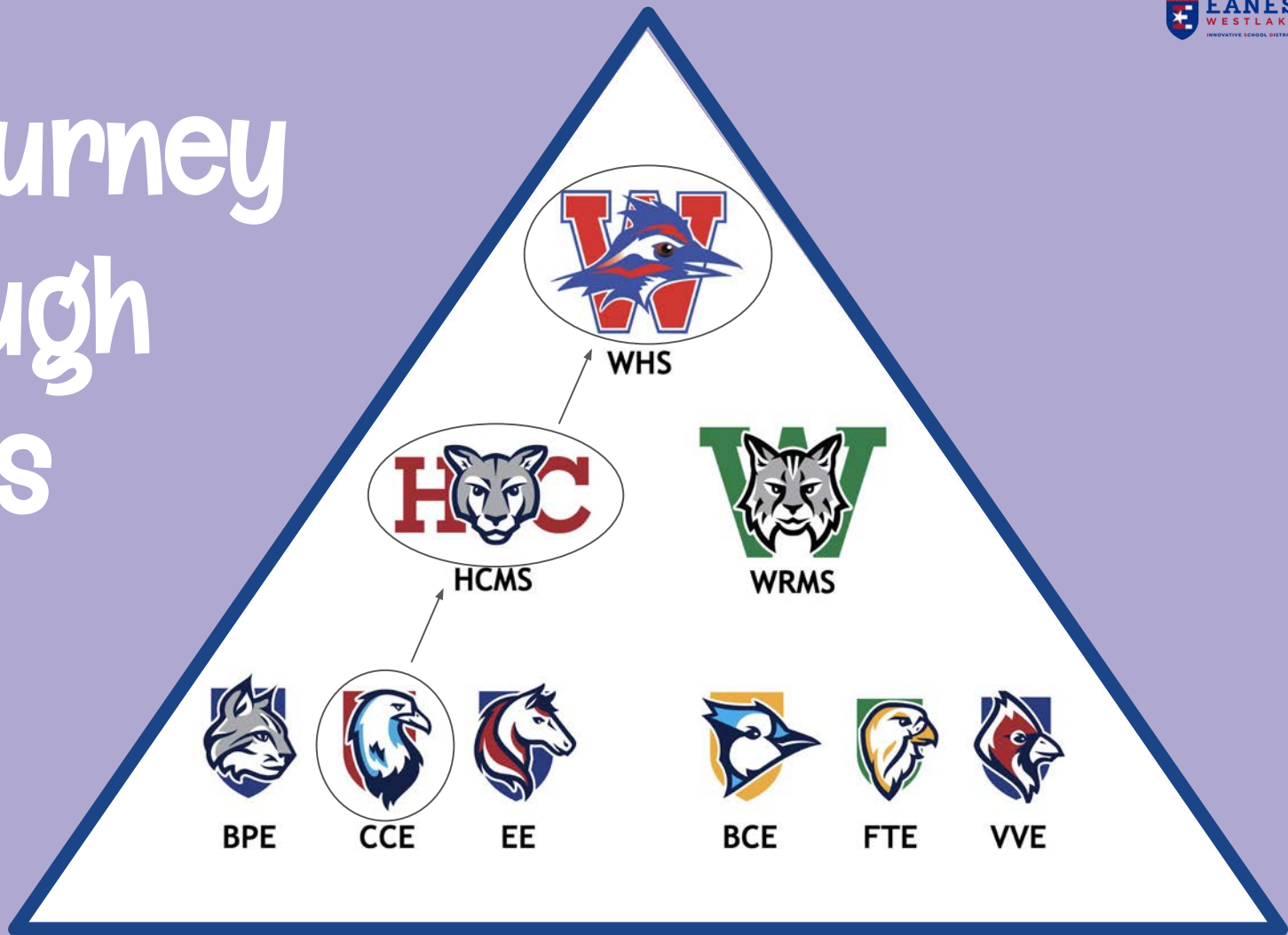

Eanes ISD staff work diligently to support students with dyslexia, special education goals, or Section 504 Plans through specific, research-based instruction and appropriate accommodations and/or modifications. We invite you to learn more about these programs using the links below.

Special Education & Section 504 Services - We are committed to providing every student with a disability an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Section 504 Services in the least restrictive environment that addresses the student's unique needs and goals.

Dyslexia - Every Kindergarten & First Grade student is required to be screened for dyslexia using a state mandated dyslexia screener. Results from this screener are shared with the parents of students who present characteristics of dyslexia.

Attendance notifications are sent by phone, email and/or text message when your child is marked absent from school.

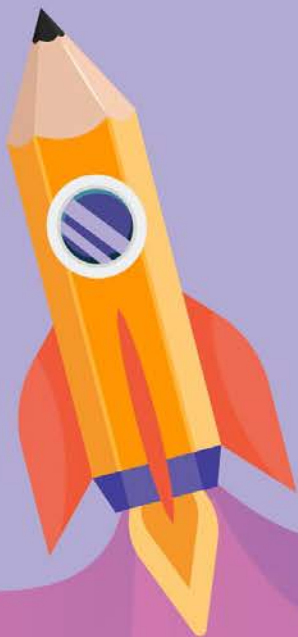

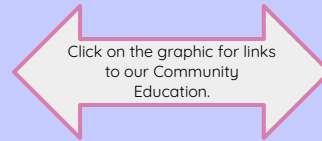

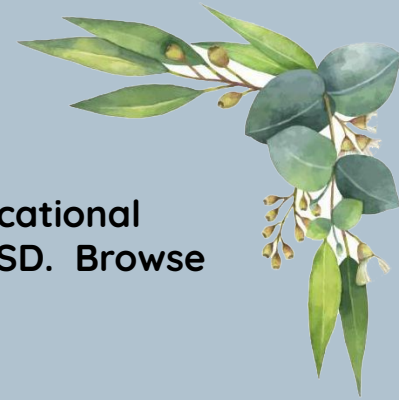

OVERALL STUDENT GROWTH



Each elementary campus provides students with **art**, **physical education**, and **music** instruction. Students also attend monthly Social-Emotional Counseling classes with a certified **school counselor**. In addition, each campus also has a school **librarian** on staff. On-site student support and staff development are provided through **Educational Partners** on every elementary campus.

DISTRICT SAFETY

A critical component of safe schools is a uniform response to any incident. Weather events, fires, accidents, intruders and other threats to safety are scenarios that are planned and trained for by school and district staff.

- Each campus is equipped with **automatic locking exterior doors**, **cameras** that scan the property, and **emergency safety plans**.
- Visitors must ring a **doorbell** before gaining access to campuses.
- Eanes ISD utilizes the **RAPTOR System** for all visitors. This is a computer software system that enhances school security by reading visitor drivers' licenses, comparing information to a sex offender data base, alerting campus administrators if a match is found, then (assuming no match was made) printing Visitor badges that include a photo.
- **Employees** are **trained**, fingerprinted, and have a background check performed prior to employment..

**A DAY IN THE LIFE
OF A
KINDERGARTENER**




Students arrive at school and are assisted down to their classroom in the Annex.



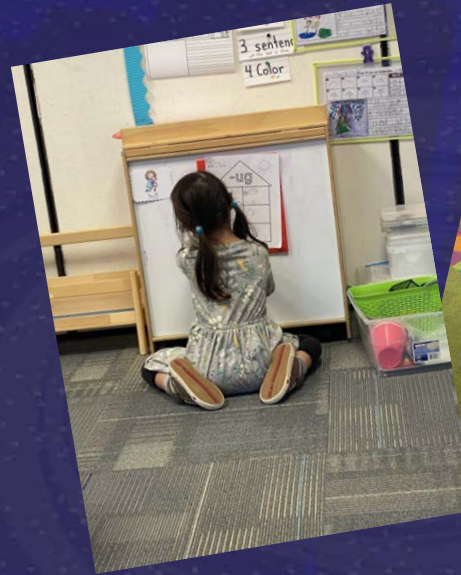


Once at their classroom they unpack their belongings, hang up their backpack, greet their classmates and teachers, and settle in for their school day.





The day school begins with a Morning Meeting where teachers and students build community by sharing, singing songs, and learning important social and emotional skills.

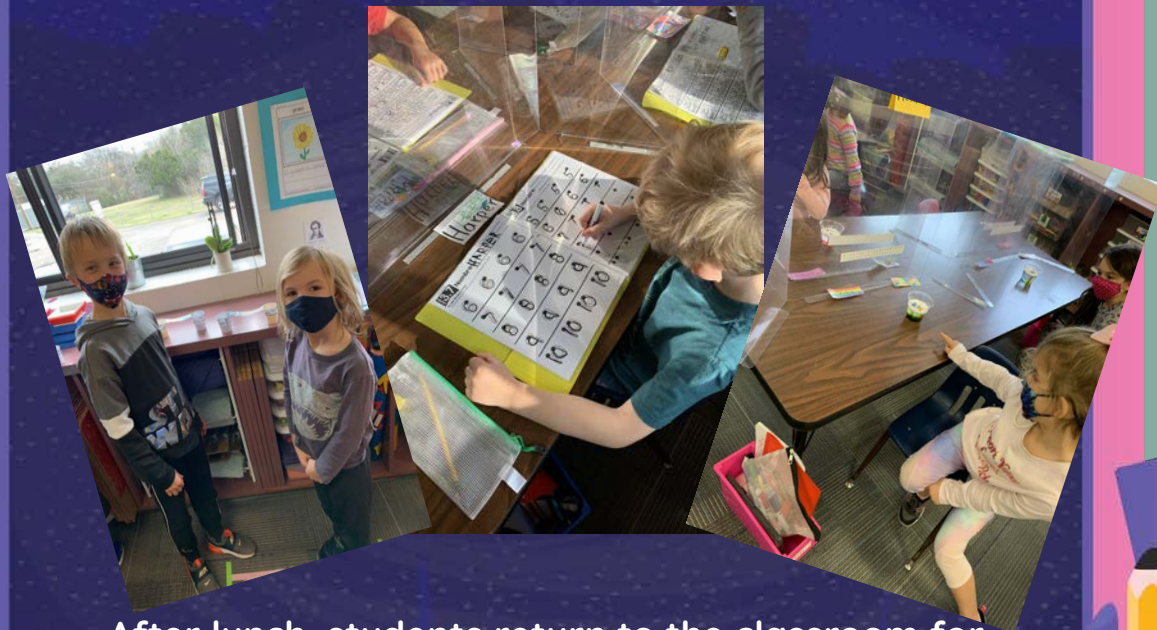


They spend the morning in an instructional block of whole group, small group, and independent activities with their classroom teacher. Once a week, the class visits Mrs. Foley in the school library.





Mid-morning, students head out to the playground for recess and then into the cafeteria for lunch.



After lunch, students return to the classroom for another instructional block that is dividing in half by afternoon recess.



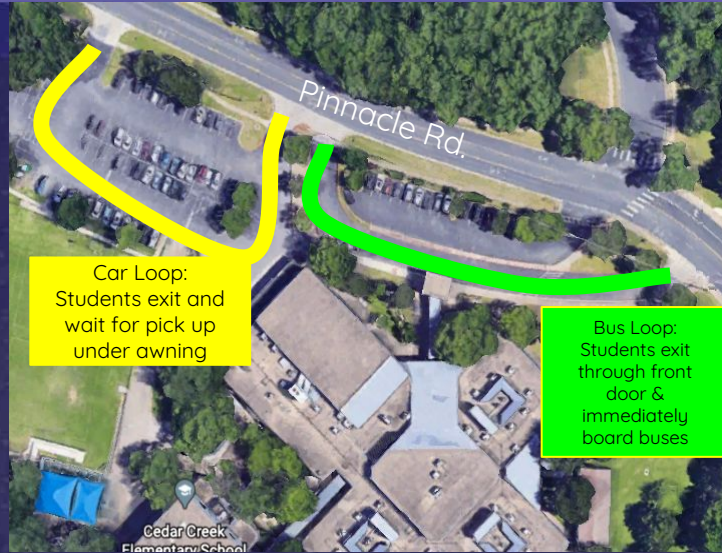


In the afternoon, classroom teachers drop the students off for special area classes. The class rotates between art, music, and P.E. over the course of 3 days.



When they return to their classroom, students eat a snack and begin FIT (Focused Instructional Time). This is a time where no new instruction is given, but students are able to spend time in reteach or enrichment from classroom teachers and campus support specialists.

At the end of the day, students pack up their belongings and head out for dismissal. The teachers make sure that students are taken to the proper pick-up spot to ride the bus, attend after-school care, or get picked up by car.

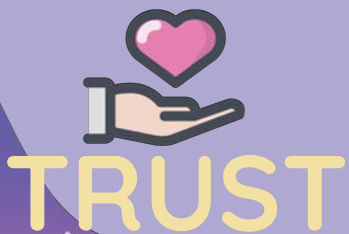

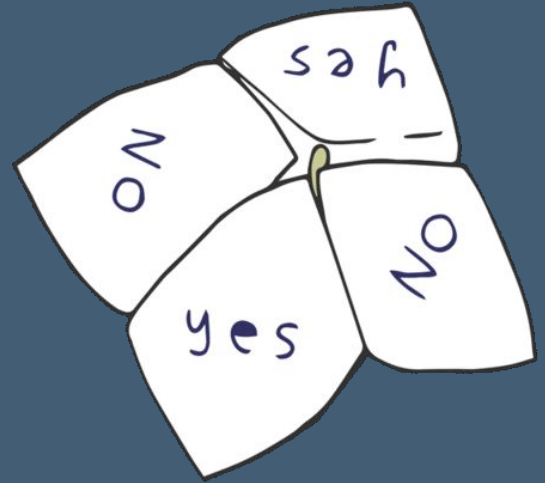
