SYSTEMS OF SUPPORT

Eanes ISD staff work diligently to support students with dyslexia, special education goals, or Section 504 Plans through specific, research-based instruction and appropriate accommodations and/or modifications. We invite you to learn more about these programs using the links below.

<u>Special Education</u> & <u>Section 504 Services</u> - We are committed to providing every student with a disability an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Section 504 Services in the least restrictive environment that addresses the student's unique needs and goals.

<u>Dyslexia</u> - Every Kindergarten & First Grade student is required to be screened for dyslexia using a state mandated dyslexia screener. Results from this screener are shared with the parents of students who present characteristics of dyslexia.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance notifications are sent by phone, email and/or text message when your child is marked absent from school.

If you know your child will be absent from school because he/she is home sick or has an appointment for the day, please notify the school by logging into the Smart Tag <u>Parent Portal</u> to document the absence. Eanes ISD will not accept phone calls to document an absence. Please, do not email the registrar.

TRANSPORTATION



Your child's safety is of the utmost important to all staff members. For this reason, Eanes ISD utilizes the <u>SMART Tag</u> system for transportation. This system is designed to provide parents with up-to-the-minute bus transportation information. It also provides dismissal information for teachers so that students get home accurately. 

In addition, each campus also has a school librarian on staff. On-site student support and staff development are provided through **Educational Partners** on every elementary campus.

DISTRICT SAFETY

A critical component of safe schools is a uniform response to any incident.
Weather events, fires, accidents, intruders and other threats to safety are scenarios that are planned and trained for by school and district staff.

- Each campus is equipped with **automatic locking exterior doors**, **cameras** that scan the property, and **emergency safety plans**.
- Visitors must ring a **doorbell** before gaining access to campuses.
- Eanes ISD utilizes the **RAPTOR System** for all visitors. This is a computer software system that enhances school security by reading visitor drivers' licenses, comparing information to a sex offender data base, alerting campus administrators if a match is found, then (assuming no match was made) printing Visitor badges that include a photo.
- **Employees** are **trained**, fingerprinted, and have a background check performed prior to employment..
